Tuition Aid Rules:

- 1. Members Children and Step Children living with member are eligible. Grandchildren are not eligible.
- 2. Only one winner per family per year, though a single member may have more than one entry in the drawing.
- 3. Student must be attending a Catholic School, other private schools and public schools are not eligible for the drawing.
- 4. There will be three (3) High School at \$600 each and five (5) Grade School at \$300 each year in the drawing.
- 5. All Tuition Aid applications and Council dues must be current by May 1st Each year to be eligible for the drawing.
- 6. Each Member submitting for Tuition Aid must sell two BBQ Raffle Books which directly fund the Tuition Aid Program.
- 7. Member must work three events at KC4175 and Students over 12 years old must work Service Hours once in past year.
